The most “famous” buildings in Izee. On the right is the school which is still owned by the Grant County School District (for future use?) and therefore somewhat maintained. The building at the left is the “teacherage”, housing for Izee’s teacher.



Izee Grange Hall. Occasionally an event is still held here.

Across the road from the Grange is a new, large, ranch residence. I have not photographed this building because I have not been able to make contact with the owner for permission.
